



Dear Resident,

This Authority is always looking for ways to keep our rates as low as possible. One of our major cost areas is the maintenance of our collection system pipes, manholes, grinder pumps, and central pump stations. In recent years, these costs have increased in part because of the placement of material into the sewer system which cause blockages and equipment failures.

The following is a list of the most common items that should not be placed in the sewer system.



Glass	Kitty litter
Metal	Flammable materials
Abrasive materials including Gravel, Sand, Aquarium Stone, and Coffee Grounds	Cooking oil, lubricating oil, Paint
Seafood shells	Strong chemicals
Socks, rags, cloths	Gasoline or diesel fuel
Plastic	Storm water
Sanitary napkins	Wipes of all kinds (and other products marked "flushable")
Disposable diapers	

Please do your part to help control costs by making sure that everyone in your house hold is aware of the types of things that should not be put into the sewer system. If you have any questions or need additional information, please call our office.
